Drone Flying Facility
Rules and Regulations**

NOTICE!! All patrons using this area must follow all rules posted below; failure to do so will result in the individuals being unable to use drones.

1. Drones may only be flown within the defined boundaries of this designated area (see corresponding map). Drone flying will be restricted to within the corners marked within this designated area only.
2. Drones must be kept below 60 feet in altitude in this area.
3. Drone user is responsible for adhering to all state and federal laws and requirements for drone usage and must be able to provide validation of compliance at any time either to local law enforcement – emergency management, WCPRD park staff, or FAA officials.
4. Drones shall not be more than 55 lbs. in weight.
5. Fly within visual-line-of sight only.
6. Do not fly drones around other drones in area; keep your space.
7. Drones cannot be used to follow or film other patrons in the park and must stay within the designated drone area.
8. Drones may only be flown during daylight hours and during times in which the park is open.
9. Never fly over groups of people, public events, buildings, or athletic / walking trail areas.
10. WCPRD is not responsible for any damage / theft / vandalism / or destruction of patron / drone user property.
11. Drone users accepts all personal liability and risk in flying his/her drone in this area.
12. Drone user is responsible for any / all damage to WCPRD property and will be held legally liable for any injury caused to patrons or other park users if caused by his/her drone.
13. WCPRD has the right and authority to discontinue any individual's use of a drone if deemed a public safety risk, or if user is not following the posted rules.
14. Drones shall not be flown during lightning / thunder / severe weather events / snow events / high wind days (above 25 mph).
15. Drone users must park in regular park-designated parking spaces (Amy Milliken Shelter Lot or Senior Center Rear Lot).
16. NO careless or reckless operations will be permitted.
17. NO items can be suspended underneath the drone.
18. Drones shall not be operated from operators in vehicles (moving or stationary).
