DRONE, REMOTE CONTROL AIRPLANE, AND
EXPERIMENTAL AIRCRAFT POLICY

WCPRD has adopted the following policy and guidelines concerning the use of drones, remote control planes, and experimental aircraft on WCPRD properties. No day-to-day, at-random, and/or individual use of drones and/or remote control planes shall be permitted on Parks properties. WCPRD, however, will permit the use of these devices “**only**” as a **scheduled one-day special event**. Such one-day events will need to follow the criteria listed below:

- Events must be scheduled through the WCPRD Office and the RecTrac Scheduling system.
- Event locations will be selected by WCPRD and will be within a controlled space for a specific amount of time. Safety boundaries/course layouts will be approved by WCPRD in conjunction with the event organizers, and park staff will be present to supervise the event site.
- Event insurance policies will be required.
- Payment for the rental of the specific park property will be required.
- All WCPRD policies relevant to the event will be in effect during these types of events (i.e., Code of Ethics, Severe Weather, Animal, Field Playability, etc.)
- Event coordinators will indemnify and hold harmless Warren County Government officers, directors, judge executives, county officials, and employees from and against all claims, demands, liabilities, suits, damages, costs, and expenses of every kind and description, including penalties and reasonable attorney fees.
