**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SUMMIT BOULEVARD, GRAND TETON WAY,
PIKES PEAK WAY AND SIERRA NEVADA WAY – LOCATED IN SUMMIT
SUBDIVISION, SECTION 1 – AS COUNTY ROADS AND AUTHORIZING
MAINTENANCE THEREON**

WHEREAS, it is the intent and purpose of the Warren Fiscal Court to make Summit Boulevard, Grand Teton Way, Pikes Peak Way and Sierra Nevada Way, located in Summit Subdivision, Section 1, as County Roads; and,

WHEREAS, the condition of the above mention roads is such that they will require minimal maintenance according to the standards, as set forth by the Warren County Road Department, which said standards are adopted by Warren Fiscal Court; and,

WHEREAS, establishing these roads as County Roads will promote the general health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Warren County, Kentucky.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF WARREN COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, that **Summit Boulevard, Grand Teton Way, Pikes Peak Way and Sierra Nevada Way**, located in Summit Subdivision, Section 1, as dedicated in Plat Book 37, Page 428-430, and more particularly described in the attached description, and plat copy, which are referenced herein and incorporated herewith (as Attachment A and B), shall be incorporated into the **Warren County Road System**.

This adoption is conditional for one year upon the proper functioning of all water drainage structures and roadways installed by the developer and property owner prior to

acceptance. Warren County does not, in any way, accept responsibility for any problem associated with the water drainage created or aggravated by the road ways, drainage easements or other structures designed or contracted by the developer or property owner prior to this adoption. The Warren County Road Engineer is hereby authorized to perform initial and periodic maintenance on said roads according to the standards or Warren Fiscal Court.

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to KRS 67.077 in that it was published in summary form on the 20th day of February, 2010, and was introduced and read on the 19th day of February, 2010, and given final reading on the 8th day of March, 2010, and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon signature, recordation and publication in summary form pursuant to KRS Chapter 424 and KRS 67.077 Subsection 3.
