A request for an Energy Efficiency inspection should typically occur once all insulation has been installed that will be concealed by interior coverings. Any remaining insulation to be installed that is not concealed will be inspected during final inspection.

Effective **October 1, 2022**, an electrical Rough-In inspection will no longer automatically assign a Framing inspection for the structure.
